***INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY** So far, besides wind our weather has been pretty mild. For those of us who have lived here awhile, you know the winters can be surprisingly icy, snowy and cold with the Frazer Valley wind. What happens to school schedule if we wake up to snow and ice?

Our policy is to follow the Ferndale School District, which means: If they do not have school, neither will we. They make the decision to cancel school based on the driving conditions throughout our district. You may look out your window, and think it may not look bad, however we have many families and staff traveling from various areas around the district and we need to ensure it is safe for all.

How do we know if school has been canceled? There are many resources.

-Cable T.V. like channels 4 and 5 will have school closure reports for Ferndale Schools

-Local Radio Stations like KISM, KAFE, KGMI will have Ferndale Schools Report

-Ferndale School District Website will be updated, usually by 5am each morning.

-The School District also has an Inclement Weather line to call: 360-383-9888 and it will have a recording of the current status.

-You can also check our Loving Tree School Facebook page, and current information will be posted there as well.

How do we make up missed snow/ice days? Typically, the snow days will be tacked on to the end of the school year. So our last day of school in June, may change, depending upon snow days.

*NOTE: In extreme cases, like we had a few years ago, we actually canceled spring break and made up one week of school then, as there were 12 snow days to make up! So schedule changes will be made as needed. *
